# **Constitution Day**

Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November every year. The programme begins with the reading of the Preamble of the Constitution, followed by lectures aimed at sensitizing students about their responsibilities towards constitutional values, rights, duties, and responsibilities as citizens. Students are encouraged to participate in activities such as essay competitions on themes related to constitutional values and economic thoughts of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar.

# **Road Safety Rally**

Students are encouraged to participate in activities that spread awareness among citizens on social issues such as road safety.

# **Pharmacist Day Rally**

To create awareness about the role of pharmacists in healthcare, students actively participate in the themed Pharmacist Day Rally organized every year on September 25.

### **Celebration of National Days**

Every year the institute celebrates Republic Day (January 26), Maharashtra Day (May 1), and Independence Day (August 15). The celebrations are attended by students, teaching and non-teaching staff, invitees, and guests. The programme includes flag hoisting, the National Anthem, an oath of national integrity, and distribution of sweets.

# **Leprosy Detection and Awareness**

Students voluntarily participate, in association with government and non-government organizations, in national health programme implementation. They have extended their services in leprosy detection and awareness campaigns.

### **Health Check-up Camp**

Students voluntarily associate with government and non-government organizations to support health check-up camps. They contribute by handling dispensing and counseling counters.

# **Cleanliness Drive**

Students consistently and regularly participate in cleanliness activities on several occasions, including Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti on October 2 every year. They are also encouraged to actively participate in plantation drives.

### **Fire Safety**

Faculty, staff, and students are trained through demonstrations on precautions and measures to be adopted for fire safety and prevention of laboratory accidents.

#### **Tree Plantation**

The institute promotes tree plantation drives in which students actively participate. Various medicinal and non-medicinal saplings are planted on campus. These activities aim to raise awareness about global warming and the importance of trees in maintaining ecosystem balance. Students also take responsibility for maintenance.

### **World Pharmacist Day**

Health awareness workshops are organized on the occasion of World Pharmacist Day in association with Amravati District Women Pharmacist. The focus is on treatment adherence for tuberculosis.

### Fresher's Day

A formal welcome is extended to the newly admitted students of First Year B. Pharm., Pharm.D., and M. Pharm. by their seniors.

### **Induction Programme**
